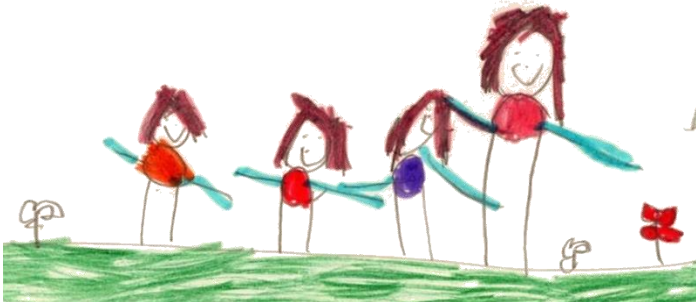
Holiday Club

The Stockton on the Forest Early Years Partnership is a group of people from Stockton who have a direct role in providing care and learning opportunities for young children.

This includes Stockton Primary School, Stockton Day Nursery and Stockton Toddler Group along with any parents and child-minders who wish to get involved.

The committee meets three times a year to organise an event for all the children in the village aged 5yrs and under.

The committee also co-ordinate maintenance of the wildlife area at the rear of the school, which is available for the whole community to enjoy.

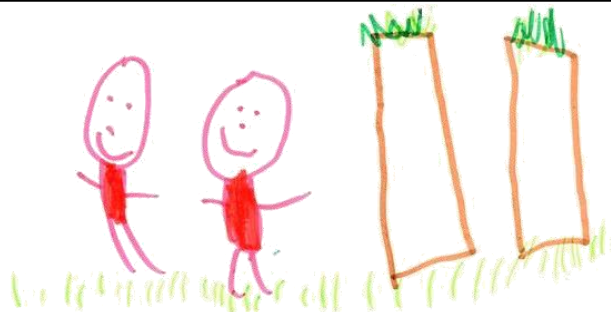

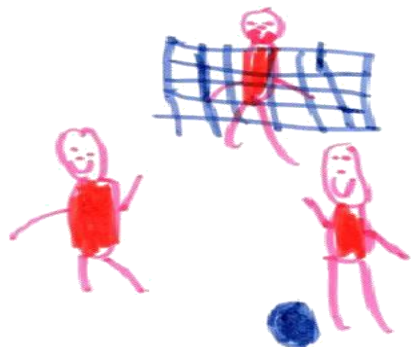

Our Nursery School is
located in the primary
school grounds, which is in
the centre of Stockton on
the Forest.

Stockton on the Forest Day Nursery offers full day
care for children aged between 0-5 years of age.

We also offer wrap-around care for children
attending Stockton Primary School and a Holiday
Club for children aged 5 - 11yrs.

Our nursery environment is safe and secure where
both children and their parents/carers are
encouraged to feel at ease with the warm, friendly
atmosphere in the company of our caring and
qualified staff. We have two rooms; the Baby and
Toddler Unit for children 0-2.5 yrs. and the Pre-
school unit for children 2.5 - 5yrs.

This outside space has recently been developed to

children and is separated for the different ages to

We are open 51 weeks of year from 7.30 - 18.30.

Stockton-on-the-Forest TODDLER GROUP

Our Toddler Group is run by parents on Thursday
mornings, 9.30-11.30am at the Village Hall during
term time.

We play with a wide variety of large and small
toys, enjoy crafts, gardening, dressing up and
song time, and eat a healthy snack whilst our
carers have a cup of tea and a chat. All parents
help with the running of the group, such as
setting up, preparing snacks and drinks, washing
up and tidying away.

We are actively involved with other Village groups
such as providing displays for the Greenfingers
Festival of Gardening, Church Harvest Festival,
Christmas Tree Festival and Easter Celebrations.
We also visit the Reception Class at Stockton
School once a term, as part of the SOFEY
Partnership.

It only costs approx. £3 per week.

We operate a drop in system so there is no pre-
booking and you don't have to commit to every
week. However we occasionally reach capacity and
have to operate a waiting list. If you are from the
