We have regularly discussed on the appearance of the parish, Yorkshire Marathon, City of York Local Plan, Barr Lane Proposed Closure, Strensall with Towthorpe PC Neighbourhood Plan, Speed Management, Hopgrove Lane South – Left Filter Lane, Fracking, A64 proposed improvement schemes.

Thanks to all the support from Fiona, all the Counsellors and for the reports from John, David and NY police on Footpaths. Foss Internal Drainage Board, Stockton Hall Hospital and local crime and to City Counsellor Paul Dougherty.

We have maintained and inspected play area, litter bins, benches, salt bins and bus shelters throughout the parish and had some interesting discussions on dog poo, pot holes and fracking. We have awarded grants to the church for £400 to maintain the grounds, Village hall £300 for new tables and the cricket club £500 towards a new mower

Planning, a relatively quiet year with only 13 planning consultations discussed. Improvements have been made to the Foot path near tom's shop the footpath outside the hospital and a new bus shelter near fox with support from grants from out City Counsellors.

And to finish with a flurry we now have a working streetlight outside the fox inn, the road at the end of the Hollies has been finished and yellow lines repainted outside the school".
